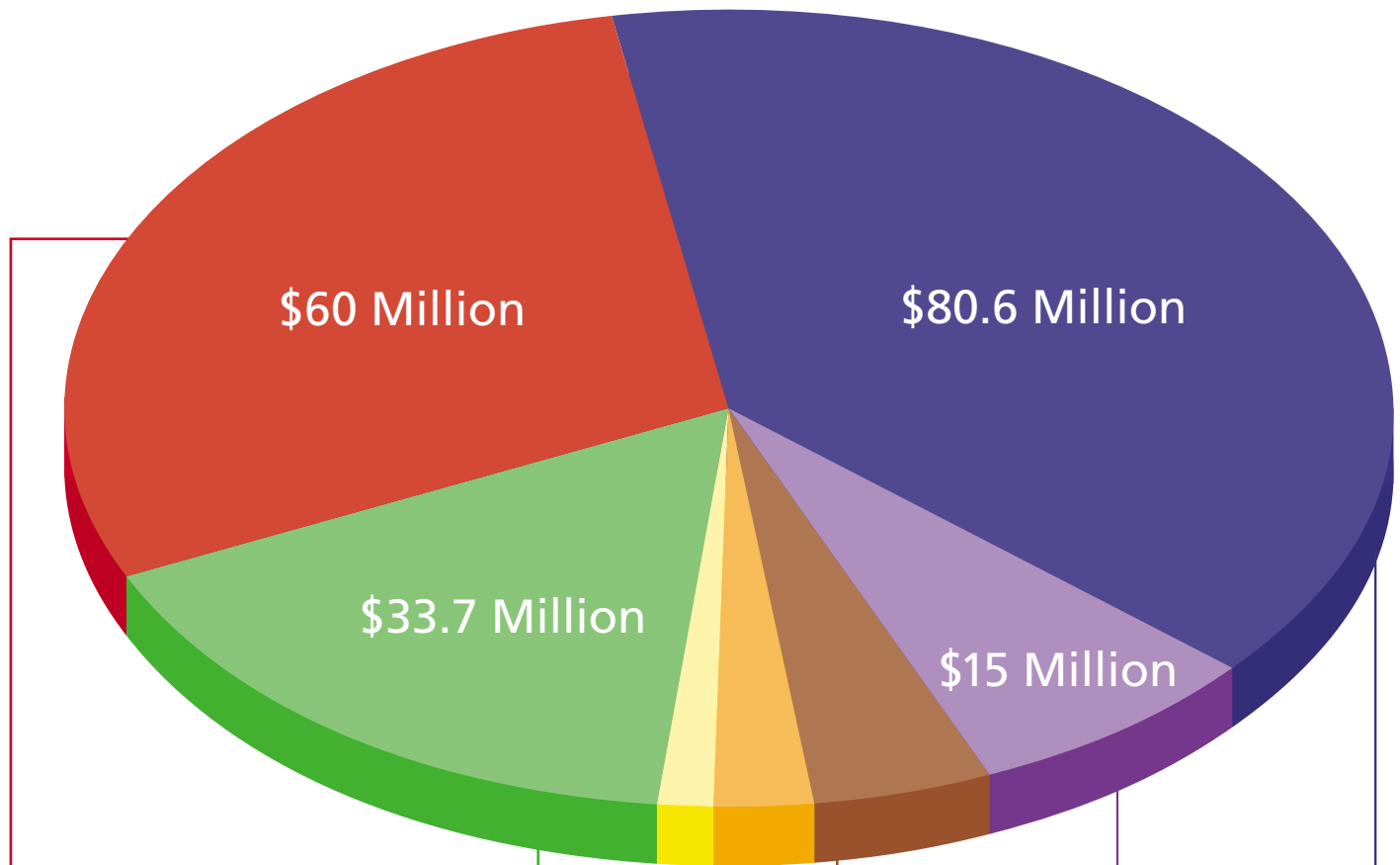


# GAMING REVENUES BENEFIT IOWA

## GENERAL FUND

Gaming revenues provide money to a state budget that helps make Iowa a better place to live, work, and raise a family.

**\$33,700,000**

## ENVIRONMENT FIRST

Gaming revenues earmarked for this purpose are improving our state's natural resources and recreational spaces, as well as the DNR's Resource Enhancement and Protection Program.

**\$2,800,000**

## GAMBLERS TREATMENT PROGRAM

The Iowa gaming industry complements its commitment to responsible gambling with \$2.8 million in funds for state treatment programs.

## SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE

This appropriation specifically addresses the need of Iowa's aging schools.

## VISION IOWA

Vision Iowa funds will be used to finance twenty year bonds to support major local projects that will foster new cultural and tourism attractions.

**\$80,600,000**

## REBUILD IOWA INFRASTRUCTURE FUND

Gaming revenues help fund numerous state facility improvement projects, such as: Hall of Justice construction, Statehouse interior renovation, Regents University building renovations, Iowa Communications Network, a variety of community and tourist attractions, State Fair renovations and historic site preservation.
